#### SeeSaw is for...


- Sharing and celebrating student learning
- Collecting student learning to demonstrate growth over time
- Providing families with greater insight into our school day
- Communicating admin messages with school and home

## SeeSaw is NOT for...

- Discussing student behaviour
- Back and forth communication with families
- Shaming students with photos of incomplete work
- Showing what students haven't done

## What should a SeeSaw post contain?

- Photos/videos/work samples of student learning
- A caption explaining what students are learning, not just what they are doing
- Links to Australian Curriculum or EYLF
- Language connected to our values Curious, Inclusive, Connected



### **Teacher Wellbeing**

Teachers are discouraged from responding to parent messages outside of standard work hours.

Teachers should monitor their own time and workload when deciding when to upload student work to SeeSaw. It is not always necessary for posts to be made on the day of the work being completed and it is not expected that teachers be posting late at night.

Teachers are encouraged to schedule regular time in their week so that it doesn't become overwhelming.

# How often should I post?

The minimum expectations is that each student will have 4-6 posts each term that show or demonstrate evidence of individual learning goals and growth. This could include a video of reading, writing sample, maths strategy etc...

As well as individual items, teachers should include whole class posts that articulate whole class teaching focuses such as inquiry questions, art, significant events/activities etc... This should happen at least once per fortnight.
